Eagles Collection Arrangements

It has been brought to our attention that it is difficult for parents to see which children are being let out of class at the end of the day. HOW TO MEASURE YOUR CHILD

Measure the actual body measurements as this is far more accurate than measuring over clothes.

CHEST: Measure around the chest at the fullest part, placing the tape close up under the arms.

COLLAR: Measure around the base of the neck where the collar sits, inserting two fingers between the neck and tape to allow growth.

WAIST: Measure around the natural waistline.

TROUSER LENGTH: Measure the inside leg from crotch to floor without shoes on.

HIPS: Measure around your hips, 20cm (8") below your natural waistline.

SKIRT LENGTH: Measure from the waist down to where you would want the hem.

DRESS & PINAFORE LENGTH: Measure from nape of neck to length required.

Upcoming Road Works

**FOOTWAY SURFACE TREATMENT
IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR VISITORS**

On behalf of Staffordshire County Council, AMEY will be carrying out preventative maintenance to breathe new life into the footpaths in Bednall Village over the next few weeks, dependent upon the weather conditions.

Work is planned to be carried out in Bednall Village between **Wednesday 31st March and Saturday 3rd April**.

THE PROCESS

The treatment is known as Micro-surfacing, which will form a new surface to the footway and protect the existing structure, prolonging the life expectancy, as well as providing a uniform appearance and better slip resistance, all with minimum inconvenience.

After approximately two hours following application, the material will have hardened sufficiently for it to be walked on (four hours for it to be carefully driven over), and **we ask that you do not walk or drive over the wet material** before this time as it is likely that some of the emulsion will be picked up on shoes or tyres, and we are unable to accept any liability for damage to footwear, vehicles, flooring or driveways. Weather conditions can affect the time to harden, so please check your shoes before entering your home or vehicle.

HOW CAN I HELP?

To help us complete this work with minimal inconvenience to you, please follow this advice:

Please ensure that vehicles are parked away from the work area whilst the work is in progress, making especially certain that they are NOT parked on the footway.

Please keep children and pets away from the new surface, for safety and cleanliness.

Please ensure that you check your shoes before entering your home as bitumen marks can be difficult to remove. Please try to avoid driving over or parking your car on the newly laid material as this may cause damage to the new surface.

COMMON LANE ROAD CLOSURE DETAILS

In order to keep both the public and our workforce safe a phased road closure will be put in place on Common Lane, Bednall.

The road closure will be phased to enable access to Cock Lane / School lane at all times.

When work is taking place between Vicarage Lane and Cock lane access will be made via Teddersley Road.

During the short period when work is taking place alongside and opposite All Saints Church, access will be available via A34 Stafford Road.

A Road closure timetable (See below) has been arranged in order to accommodate parents and associated traffic during school drop off and collection times.

Access to properties within the closure points will be maintained (Please seek out the Traffic Management Marshall on site) however all traffic must abide by the signed diversion route.

Please limit vehicle travel where possible, expect vehicle movement disruptions, give yourself additional travel time and drive slowly and carefully as you should expect vehicles and workmen to be present.

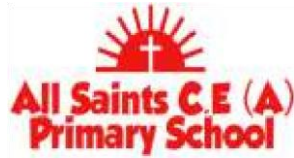
