#### Headteacher's Message

I can't believe we are already half way to Christmas. The children have worked so hard all term and I can't tell you how rewarding it is to see them thrive after the last 10 months.

Teachers are definitely ready for a break, however, so will hand your children back to you tonight and wish you a happy and memorable half term.

We recently had a very positive meeting that outlined how well children and staff have all settled this term and the positive feel that there is in school.

Parents' main concerns were around the reducing numbers of pupils in school and the high level of Special Needs Children there are on role.

It was highlighted that the additional number of SEND children brought with it additional staffing, and although this didn't really reduce anyone's workload, it did bring more adults in to school and enabled the team spirit to flourish.

The issue with pupil numbers remains our number one concern. Many ideas were discussed on how we could publicise the school more widely and what could be done to create a positive reputation. These included:

- Leafleting show homes on the new developments
- Leafleting doctor's surgeries and other amenities such as child minders
- Advertising the events held in school as widely as possible
- Create an Instagram account for the school that works like Dojo so parents can share it on Social media
- Higher profile in the local magazines
- Invite nurseries in for their children to experience the school setting
- Promoting Christmas events

We also discussed ways to widen the experiences children receive at All Saints:

- Build closer links with Walton High pyramid concern
- Build more trips into the curriculum
- Look at one off experiences such as attending Blue Peter
- Attend school games and other sports activities


#### Height & Weight Checks for Reception and Year 6
