Headteacher's Message

This week has seen a lot of activity at All Saints. Teachers have been busy looking at children's assessments and reporting to parents about the progress they are making. Thank you to all of the parents that have been into school for appointments - you will have noticed that each appointment began with a comment about attendance. It is so important that we get children in school in order to give them the best opportunities possible. Thank you for your continued support and efforts with this. There are some children that are regularly late. We are beginning to look at the amount of minutes of learning that are lost due to lateness, in some cases they add up to more than the equivalent time of a whole school day. Please can we ask that you do your best to get your children through the school gate from 8.45-8.55am.

The children have been preparing for our Easter service this week, there has been lots of singing around school, which has been so lovely to hear. We have been keeping healthy with swimming and with a variety of PE lessons including yoga in Sparrows. After Easter Mrs Gliddon will be working with the Year 6 playleaders to develop playtimes, to include other activities including basketball and cheerleading.

Safeguarding continues to be a priority in school as we continue to develop practice and processes. I have had a meeting this week with a lead safeguarding officer from the Staffordshire Safeguarding team, to ensure our practice is effective. I have also introduced the children to our new postbox in the entrance hall. Designed to give children another way of communicating with grown ups about any worries or concerns they have. A brand new safeguarding section has also been created on our school website, it will signpost you to all the safeguarding information you need.

For those of you joining us recently, our Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) is myself, Mrs Scott. We also have two Deputy Designated Safeguarding Leads (DDSL), and those are Mrs Mayhew and Mrs Shale. If you have any concerns about a child, please inform any of these members of staff or you can use the contact numbers on the website.

Other activities this week include visits from our pupil premium lead, Mrs Clarke, we have had a meeting with our IEB to inform them of all the wonderful things happening at All Saints and the Year 6 children have been tree planting!

Please look out for the links to the parents survey, it's really important that we know your views. We will also be sending out interim pupil progress reports next week too.

Finally, I look forward to welcoming those that can make our special Easter morning next Friday. Starting with a service in church at 11.30am. We then invite a grown up from each family to join their child/children at school for lunch. Please bring an Easter themed picnic. Children that have already ordered a school dinner can still have those. We will then finish the term with a family Egg hunt on the field.

School closes next week at 1pm.


