In keeping with tradition, the fete will be opened by the children of All Saints who have been practicing hard with Miss Connolly to choreograph a super dance to showcase our talents.


It's a lovely event with lots going on so, if you are able to attend to support not only the school but also our local community it would be lovely to see you there.



#### **School** meals

From September, Edwards and Ward will be supplying our school meals - they will still be freshly prepared at Castlechurch Primary School and Siobhan will continue to serve the meals. There will be a new menu (see below) which will be available on ParentPay in the summer holidays and we will let you know when you can make your selections. Please be advised there has been an increase in cost to £2.83 per meal (this will still remain free to pupils in Reception/Y1/Y2 as well as Pupil Premium children).

#### Special Diets Registration
