This week we have been planting for pollinators! We learned about the main 4 parts of a plant, what they do and how we eat them! The children had no idea that they regularly eat roots, stems, leaves and flowers! We then discussed what plants need to stay healthy before using our measuring skills to carefully plant English bluebells and daffodils around the edge of our school field!

Greatest Showman Confidence Building Day

Last Friday we had our first enrichment day - The Greatest Showman.

The day taught the children a variety of new skills and tricks whilst focusing on improving their self-esteem and confidence. Celebrating what they can already do and their creative ideas and encouraging their resilience and perseverance in practising new things.

Sparrows and Doves had their session together in the morning and Eagles in the afternoon. The sessions were about confidence building and focussed on emotions, mind-set, creativity, working together and practical skills, through various fun activities including group games, making a positive affirmation poster, gratitude games, breath work/calming strategies, practising circus skills and parachute games, and a final performance of 'The Greatest Showman' song.

The children had such an amazing time and laughed so much and a few even stepped outside of their own comfort zones!
