We think about people in the world who don't always have enough to eat,

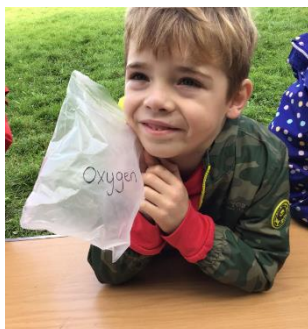
We pray that these people won't be hungry anymore.
